

2020 NW RULES/CLASSES/DATES

Rules:

- Day of race rules will default to the hosting tracks rules.
- All tracks must offer all of the NW series classes. Additional classes may also be offered, but will not be scored in the series. This only applies to NW race dates and is not required for the rest of a tracks regular season.
- If two classes are combined due to low rider turn out, the second class must be started on a separate row.
- Riders must attend 60% of the series races run to be eligible for a trophy.
- Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place at the end of the year.
- All riders are to verify their results directly after their mains. Once the final results from a race have been submitted, there will be no alterations made.

- If a protest is made during a race and a member of the Vancouver Flat Track Club cannot be located, please contact Sam Villanueva with any questions or concerns. 604-868-0663
- Any rider under the minimum age requirement for a class will not be scored and may not be allowed to race in that class.
- 360 style protection (ie. bull riding vest) may be required at some tracks for riders aged 15 years or younger.
- Any rider riding in an Amateur and a Pro class in the same day, will not be scored for the Amateur classes.
- Pro Purse series payouts (and any other rider payouts) will be determined at the end of the year.
- In the event of a rain out or cancellation of a race, the round may be moved to a pre-determined rain date later in the season if available. If a race makes it through all of the heat races, it will be determined whether the round will be scored off of the heat races or moved to a rain date on a case by case basis.

Points Structure:

1st - 25 points	7th - 12
2nd - 20	8th - 11
3rd - 17	9th - 10
4th - 15	10th - 9
5th - 14	11th - 8
6th - 13	12th - 5

In the event that there is a tie for a championship, that tie will be broken based on the number of wins in the series. If that does not break a tie, the number of second-place finishes will be compared, then thirds, fourths, etc. until the tie is broken. If a tie remains, then the rider who raced the earliest race date with the highest finish, will be ranked higher.

Classes:

- 65cc - Open traction
- 85cc - Open traction
- 250cc - 12 years or older
- 450cc - 14 years or older
- Open Amateur - 450cc and up. 14 years or older
- Vintage - 1979 or older, twin shock
- Ladies
- Veteran +30 - 30 years or older
- Super Senior +50 - 50 years or older
- Pro M/C - 16 yrs or older

*All classes are class C tires unless otherwise noted
